This liberation is achieved as faculty and students, led by wonder about the nature of reality, look twice, ask why, seek not merely facts but fundamental principles, strive for an integration of all knowledge, and express themselves precisely and eloquently.

Saint Mary's College holds that the mystery which inspires wonder about the nature of existence is revealed in the person of Jesus Christ, giving a transcendent meaning to creation and human existence. Nourished by its Christian faith, the College understands the intellectual and spiritual journeys of the human person to be inextricably connected. It promotes the dialogue of faith and reason; it builds community among its members through the celebration of the Church's sacramental life; and it defends the goodness,

dignity, and freedom of each person, and fosters sensitivity to social and ethical concerns. Recognizing that all those who sincerely quest for truth contribute to and enhance its stature as a Catholic institution of higher learning, Saint Mary's welcomes members from its own and other traditions, inviting them to collaborate in fulfilling the spiritual mission of the College.

As a Lasallian college, Saint Mary's holds that students are given to its care by God and that teachers grow spiritually and personally when their work is motivated by faith and zeal. Appendix

LATIN HONORS

Latin Honors accord graduating seniors recognition for academic excellence achieved over the duration of their undergraduate years at Saint Mary's College. There are three categories of honors:

- * Cum Laude: Seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 3.50–3.69 as of March 1, 2024.
- ** Magna Cum Laude: Seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 3.70–3.84 as of March 1, 2024.
- *** Summa Cum Laude: Seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 3.85–4.00 as of March 1, 2024.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn by today's college professors links them with their counterparts in the medieval universities. Caps and gowns were standard daily attire for educated persons as early as the twelfth century and undoubtedly evolved from the robes, hoods, and caps worn for warmth in the frigid stone abbeys by the monks and friars who were the early students and masters.

The traditional cap is the mortarboard ornamented with a black tassel or, in the case of a doctor's cap, a gold tassel. A number of colleges and universities specify a soft velvet tam instead of the stiff mortarboard in their academic attire.

The academic hood hangs down the back of the gown, denoting the field of study of the wearer and the university awarding the degree. The inner satin lining represents the colors of the university awarding the degree, and the upper trim's colors represent the School awarding the degree.

New graduates of Saint Mary's College wear colored hoods representing their school. Banners decorating the stage area reflect the colors of the schools: Economics and Business Administration, Drab Liberal Arts, White Science, Gold

Members of the governing body of a college or university, whatever their degrees may be, are entitled to wear doctor's gowns. They may also wear a hood representing the institution they govern, rather than that from which they hold a degree.
